

DON'T MOVE FIREWOOD

Keep these pests
out of Vermont!



**Asian
Longhorned Beetle**
.30" – .50" Wide

This wood-boring insect can kill many hardwoods. Its preferred tree is maple.



**Spotted
Lanternfly**
Adults are 1" Long

This sap-feeding insect can harm crops and is a nuisance to people outdoors.



Oak Wilt
5" – 9" Long,
2" – 4" Wide

This fungal disease has killed millions of oak trees in the U.S.

FACT

Invasive tree killing pests can hitchhike in your firewood. Moving firewood long distances can spread forest insects and disease that threaten our forests. Buy firewood where you burn it.
