

Note: The only difference between Class A and Class B weeds is that Class A are not yet known to occur in the state. Both are legally prohibited from purchase, selling, transporting, etc.

The attached Watch List has no legal authority, but are certainly things that we recommend be avoided and may be added to the Quarantine list at a later date.
